4)The following is a notice of cancer and tuberculosis screening

Hiratsuka City will provide citizens with cancer and tuberculosis screenings this year, too. For the location and schedule of the group checkup, please see the Hiratsuka City website. Cancer screening is free for those over 70 years old. Tuberculosis screening is free for all people.

1. Gastric cancer screening is for people of 40 years old and older, and the cost is 1,400 yen.

2. Colorectal cancer screening is for those of 40 years old and older, and the cost is 500 yen.

3. Uterine cancer is for women of 20 years old and older, and the cost is 1,000 yen.

4. Breast cancer is for people of 40 years old and older, even-numbered age, like 20, 22, 24 and so on. The cost is 2,000 yen.
