Hiratsuka City will hold a J-Alert test broadcast on Wednesday, February 12 at around 11:00 a.m. J-Alert is an emergency alert system to warn the public of major disasters and missile attacks. (J-Alert is an alarm system that broadcasts simultaneously throughout Japan in the event of a major disaster or missile attack.
