# 1) <u>Today's first news is about theft incidents that occurred in Hiratsuka city</u> in January 2025.

Totally 30 cases of bicycle thefts occurred in Hiratsuka City. They occurred in almost every town in Hiratsuka City. In particular, 6 cases occurred in Amanuma, 5 cases each in Beniya Cho and Tamura. There have been cases of bicycles being stolen while parked on the premises of residences. Also, there have been cases of bicycles being stolen even if they were locked. When you park your bicycle, we recommend that you use a wire-type lock that is sold at home centers, and so on. There were 7 cases of motorcycle thefts totally in Hiratsuka City.

Among them, there were 2 cases in Beniya Cho. When you park your motorcycle, we recommend that you use an anti-theft lock in addition to the normal lock.
