1) The next is the announcement of the match schedule of Shonan Bellmare at Lemon Gas Stadium.

Shonan Bellmare will face Nagoya Granpus on Sunday, April 6th. The game starts at 3 p.m. The admission tickets for unreserved seats are 2,500 yen for adults, and 900 yen for elementary, junior high, and high school students. Same-day purchases are an additional 500 yen.

2) Next, I would like to inform you about the paperless procedures at the city hall.

Hiratsuka City has started the "No Writing Counter" from February 4th. The "No Writing Counter" allows residents to verbally provide the necessary data at the counters when applying for documents such as resident certificates, without filling out application forms. The staff will then enter the data into the computer, completing the application process. Not all applications can be made this way, so please check the city hall's website for the procedures that are eligible. 3) The following is an announcement of free tuition at universities.

From April 2025, families with three or more children will be free of charge for university tuition, regardless of the income. Short-term universities and higher vocational schools are also free of charge. However, if the child is working, it will not be eligible. If you want to apply, please complete the procedure at the university you are going to.

4) The following is a notice of changes to the rules for bicycle operation

From November 1, the rules for riding a bicycle will be strictly enforced. A fine or imprisonment will be imposed for the following violations.

1. using a cellular phone while riding a bicycle
2. If you make a phone call while riding a bicycle
3. if you ride a bicycle after drinking alcohol

It is also a violation if you lend your bicycle to a person who has been drinking alcohol and riding a bicycle.
