

1) Next is an announcement regarding the recruitment of users for the citizen farm.

Hiratsuka City has 22 citizens' farms within the city. The usage period is two years from the contract, and renewal is also possible. The usage fee ranges from 8,000 yen to 18,000 yen per year. The fee varies depending on the location of the farm. Please check the city's website for information on currently available farms. 2) Next is an announcement about the subsidy for the purchase of "annoying telemarketing prevention devices."
