

1) Next is an announcement regarding the recruitment of users for the citizen farm.

Hiratsuka City has 22 citizens' farms within the city. The usage period is two years from the contract, and renewal is also possible. The usage fee ranges from 8,000 yen to 18,000 yen per year. The fee varies depending on the location of the farm. Please check the city's website for information on currently available farms. 2) Next is an announcement about the subsidy for the purchase of "annoying telemarketing prevention devices." Hiratsuka City will subsidize half of the cost for those aged 65 or older who purchase an annoying telemarketing prevention device, with a maximum subsidy of 5,000 yen. Those interested should complete the necessary procedures at the Kiki kanri-ka which means crisis management division on the 4th floor of the city office. Unreserved seating tickets are 2,500 yen for adults and 900 yen for elementary school, junior high school, and high school students if purchased in advance. Tickets purchased on the day will cost an additional 500 yen.

May 31st is the deadline for the first installment of the light vehicle tax and fixed property tax. Since May 31st falls on a Saturday, the payment deadline will be extended to Monday, June 2nd.
