4) Update on Immigration Procedure Fees

Effective April 1, 2025, the fees for certain immigration procedures for foreign residents have been revised as follows:

- 1. Change of status of residence: $44,000 \rightarrow 46,000$
- 2. Extension of period of stay: $\$4,000 \rightarrow \$6,000$
- 3. Permanent residence application: $\$8,000 \rightarrow \$10,000$
- 4. Single re-entry permit: $\$3,000 \rightarrow \$4,000$
- 5. Multiple re-entry permit: $\$6,000 \rightarrow \$7,000$
- 6. Employment qualification certificate: $\$1,200 \rightarrow \$2,000$
