## 1. Bicycle and Motorcycle Theft in Hiratsuka (June Report)

In June, there were a total of 32 reported bicycle thefts across Hiratsuka City. Cases occurred in nearly every neighborhood, with 6 incidents in Beniya-chō and 2 each in Amanuma and Miyamatsu-chō. Some bikes were stolen even while parked inside private property or secured with locks. It's recommended to use additional wire-style locks, available at home centers, to better prevent theft.

There were also 3 reported motorcycle thefts—in Miyano-mae, Kataoka, and Tamura. When parking motorcycles, it's advised to use theft-prevention locks in addition to the standard ones.
