4. M Immigration Procedure Fee Changes

Starting April 1, 2025, fees for various residency procedures have been revised. For example:

- Changing your residence status now costs \(\frac{4}{6}\),000 (up from \(\frac{4}{4}\),000)
- Permanent residency: ¥10,000
- Re-entry permits: $\frac{4}{900}$ for single, $\frac{7}{900}$ for multiple entries
- Certificate of employment qualification: \(\frac{4}{2}\),000

5. Nuisance Call Prevention Device Subsidy
